17 people gathered to discuss the formation of a Central Coast 350 (350CC) group.

After introductions and a presentation by Bill Kucha on the nature and goals of 350.org, Bill presented the variety of options in which this group could help to deal with climate change.

We defined possible committee groups which included: Education, Science, Political action, fund raising, arts and tech support. It was determined that the group would choose a campaign to focus our efforts on. (Thank you, Monica) Campaigns include divestment/reinvestment, fossil fuel resistance, state legislation and renewable energy.

Before beginning our efforts the group decided to set the goal of educating ourselves as to the nature of this environmental work.
